



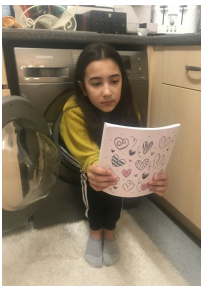
World Book Day - Year Four
