



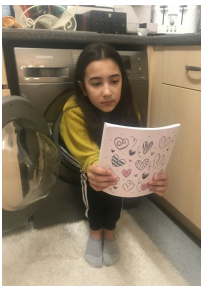
World Book Day - Year Six
