

- When: Over 80 years ago at the beginning of the Second World War
- What: School children were being evacuated to a safe place in the country



- On 3rd Sept 1939 our school closed because of the war.
- 166 pupils and their teachers were evacuated
- The school remained closed for nine months!

May 28th. The School re-opened at 9 a.m. today with 72 children in attendance, 4 of whom were Belgian refugees.

The staff included Mr H.G. Chandler, Mr Teacher, Miss E.A. Darby and Mrs A. Halsey on supply.


The School was divided into two classes, Mrs Halsey in charge of class I and Miss Darby, class II.


Air Raid Drill was taken immediately after assembly, one shelter being already available for 100 children.

In May 1940 the school opened up again with two classes. Many children remained with their teachers in the countryside and the headmaster visited them as often as he could.



When the war ended in 1945 the school closed for two whole days so everyone could celebrate!


