Dear Parents,

Despite the current restrictions, we are planning a number of activities to celebrate the end of term and the fantastic achievements of our pupils this year! A number of dates have been changed due to the Government's extension to the covid restrictions so please update your calendars.

## **Christ the Saviour Party in the Playground**

We are planning a day of celebrations to mark our 160th anniversary on Friday 9th July and pupils will be off timetable for the day (Nursery pupils who do not attend school on a Friday will have their special party on Monday 12th July). Pupils should come to school ready for a party and dressed appropriately, for example party dresses, suits and ties or cravats. We ask that pupils do not wear jeans or sportswear, if they would prefer to wear school uniform that is absolutely fine.

Our celebrations will include a street party in the playground for each year group with a picnic style meal. Please pay as you usually would for a normal school lunch via ParentPay. The menu will be as follows:
