Anti-Bullying Week: Odd Socks Day on Monday

Making sure that all children in the school are aware of how to safely prevent, recognise and report incidents of bullying is an integral part of our PSHE curriculum throughout the year. However we welcome the opportunity at this time of year to provide an extra focus on the topic with national Anti Bullying week starting on 15th November. To mark the start of Anti Bullying week children are invited to come to school on Monday wearing **odd socks** - this reminds us that differences are to be celebrated. Each year group will have dedicated time in the week to learn about this year's Anti Bullying Week theme - One Kind Word; there will be many activities taking place throughout the school including class discussions, joining in with a UK wide online lesson, theatre performances and workshops.

Covid-19 risk assessment

Cases of Covid-19 have increased at the school this week matching local data. As a result we have increased control measures at school and we advise parents to take up the offer of free lateral flow tests to support everyone in our school community and to ensure asymptomatic pupils do not attend school. Children who present with Covid symptoms should remain at home and take a PCR test. A reminder that common covid symptoms are:

- A high temperature
- A loss of taste or smell
- A persistent cough

We are finding that other common symptoms amongst children are headaches and body aches. Although children in households where there has been a positive case are no longer required to self-isolate, we ask that parents engage in daily lateral flow testing for siblings who remain at school and are sensible in their choice of out of school activities to reduce the risk of transmission.
