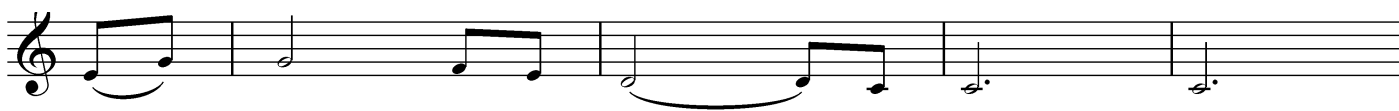

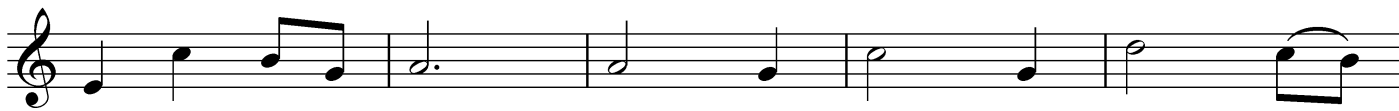



The Agnus Dei


