Dear Parents,

Through our curriculum, we aim to prepare our children to become: *educated citizens in a global world*. Over the last few weeks, pupils have been learning about the Christian Value of Wisdom. Parents' Evening - Change of Date

Arbor Contacts

We ask parents to please check that their contact details are correct on Arbor. It is a requirement that schools have at least 2 emergency contact numbers but we prefer to have 3 contacts for every child. Please check these and ensure other details on your child's Arbor profile are correct. A reminder that if you are changing any medical details that you also email this through to our medical team via the admin email as changes made by parents on Arbor are not automatically flagged to the school.

Medical Tracker

We are really pleased to be launching our new online medical communication system at the Broadway Site after half term. If your child visits the welfare room during the school day you will now receive an email rather than a medical slip to inform you of their treatment. This system will not replace the phone calls that Mrs Halliwell makes to parents but will replace paper communication. If you receive one of these emails it will be labeled: CtS Welfare Notification, and will be sent to the adults listed on Arbor as Primary Guardians. It is our intention to roll

this out across both sites by the end of the academic year if the use of this electronic system is successful. We are happy to receive feedback on this and hope it will both improve communication with parents and help us to further analyze the medical needs in our school.

Sensory Room at the Broadway Site

We are thrilled to have installed a brand new sensory room at the Broadway Site this half term. The room is used regularly by pupils from Year 3 to Year 6 who use the room to complete sensory circuits as part of their planned intervention timetable throughout the day.
