Jesus brought good news to the sick. He healed the lepers. Only one came back to thank him.



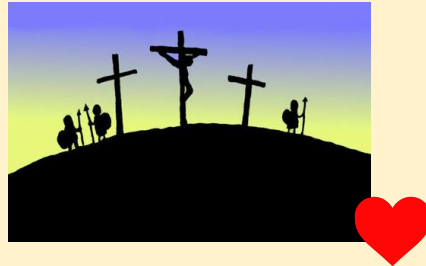
Jesus healed the man who couldn't walk and also forgave his sin.
