Dear Parents,

Our planning for PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic education) in the Spring Term includes children choosing a charity and planning a fundraising event for the chosen charity. We carry out this fundraising event to coincide with Lent so children are able to recognise their acts of service and the impact this has on others. Each year group has selected their own charity with pupils showing their usual levels of commitment and passion to helping others and showing a strong understanding of their social responsibility. Chosen charities include: The Log Cabin in Ealing which provides a setting where children and young people with additional needs or disabilities can meet and socialise; Young Minds, a charity providing young people with tools to look after their mental health; The Rainbow Trust supporting seriously ill children and their families. Thank you for encouraging your child and helping them to raise money for the charities they have chosen with their peers.

Thank you also to our parent volunteers who have recently engaged with Ms Norris to review our RSE policy (Relationships and Sex Education) which sits within the wider context of our PSHE curriculum. The intention of the parents' evening is to give parents valuable feedback on their child's learning at school and ways to support them at home.
