## Parent Governor Election

## Pupil Reports

End of year report cards were sent home in book bags on Friday. If there is anything you wish to discuss with the class teacher please email to request a phone call this week. In addition to the report cards, we also shared with parents the outcomes of the national statutory assessments that children have completed this academic year in the following year groups:

- Year 1 phonics
- Year 2 SATs scores
- Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check results
- Year 6 SATs scores

We are very pleased with the academic achievements of all our pupils once again this year. We have continued to see very strong outcomes at the end of Reception from our youngest pupils, excellent phonics outcomes for Years 1 and very high outcomes for our Year 2 cohort who will be the last year group nationally to sit the Year 2 SATS. We were also very proud of our Year 6 cohort who gained some excellent SATS results this year. They were well prepared for these tests which they sat in May, and approached them in an extremely mature and confident manner. The school received a monitoring visit during the SATS week and we were really pleased with the positive feedback on how calm and ordered the children were throughout the testing period. We are delighted that they move on to secondary school with this positive experience of national tests and some really fantastic results for which they should be very proud!

The national data has just been published and we are pleased to provide a comparative report showing our KS2 school results and national data for 2023. Our outcomes are very strong and particularly high for pupils gaining the higher standard in both Year 2 and Year 6.

We continue to be committed to a broad and balanced curriculum and we are equally pleased that our outcomes in French, music, Art, PE, RE and the Humanities are equally strong with some of our Year 6 children gaining both academic, music and sporting scholarships this year.

### **Attendance and Punctuality**

Please login to Arbor to find your child's attendance and punctuality report for this academic year. We are pleased that our school attendance is well above the national average, but like many schools we have failed to return to the attendance levels we had pre-pandemic. If your child has attendance below 90% they are classified by the Department for Education as a persistent absentee. This data is shared with the local authority and secondary schools and we will continue to work hard with families who have children with poor attendance to address their attendance barriers.

### **Parent Pay Debt**

We politely ask that parents clear any outstanding debt on parent pay before the end of the academic year. This includes all payment items- especially lunch and breakfast club payments.

### **Universal Free School Meals**

As you may be aware the Mayor of London has expanded the provision of free school meals to all pupils in state funded primary schools. This means that pupils at the Broadway Site will receive a free meal next year. All Grove Site pupils will continue to receive a free meal with the exception of Nursery pupils. We anticipate an increase in the number of pupils taking a school meal at the Broadway Site and we are adjusting our lunchtime routines and catering accordingly. Our menu will remain the same until October half term when we move to our Winter menu. A letter from the Mayor of London is attached to this email.

### **Uniform**

We have attached a uniform list along with a shoe guide for parents. Please ensure your child has the correct uniform for the new academic year. If you are experiencing financial difficulty and would like the school to arrange some pre-loved uniform for your child please contact the admin team. A few uniform reminders:

- Blazers are a compulsory uniform item at the Broadway Site.
- White socks are not part of our school uniform
- Hoodies are not permitted for PE or any other time during the school day
- School coats should be red, black or navy blue
- We have changed our Nursery uniform and will communicate this with Nursery parents directly

We know how important it is for parents to come into school to visit their child in their school learning environment and we hope the increased opportunities this year have helped you share in your child's learning.
