## Building up fluency

## THE 6 P'S:


**Pitch** 

High or low?

How musical is your voice?

Does your voice rise and fall?

What tone do you use?

**Power** 

Volume:

How loud or quiet is your voice? Why?

Can your audience hear you?

Stress:

Which words are emphasised? Why?


**Passion** 

Can you use emotion in your voice?

Are your audience excited by your reading?

Why is this vital?


Monotone = lacking in empathy and expression.

**Punctuation** 

Which marks do you recognise?

How do they dictate how you read?


Why has the writer used them?

**Pace** 

How fast do you speak?

When do you speed up or slow down? Why is this?

Are the fastest readers the best?

**Pause** 

When should you pause?

For how long?

For what purpose?

## Enjoyment

What was your favourite part of this story?

Would you read another book by this author again?

Would you recommend this book to a friend?

Does this book remind you of any others?

## Asking questions

What questions do you have about what we just read?

What are you still wondering after reading that page?

If you could ask the character a question what would you ask?



## Y3 Home Reading Prompts

### Predicting what will happen next

What could have happened before the book took place?

What do you think is going to happen next?

Why do you think that would happen?

What would you do next?

Choose a part from the story. What would you have done?

### Summarising the text (describing key events)

Can you tell me what has happened on this page in your own words?

What does \_\_\_\_ (choose a word from the text) \_\_\_\_ mean?

List the three main things that happened on this page (or pages).

What words in the text excite you? Why?

### Characters/setting

How does the character feel at \_\_\_\_\_ point in the story? How do you know?

What word shows how the character is feeling?

Describe the main character - use words from the text to help you.

Do the main character's feelings change at \_\_\_\_\_ point in the story? Why?

Choose two characters in the story. Are they the same or different? Why?
