
Listen to the hymn together - you can sing along if you would like to!

Discuss:

- Who is the King of Kings?
- Do you know which language the word Hosanna comes from?
- What does Hosanna mean?


The King of Kings is Jesus! The title 'King of Kings' tells us Jesus is powerful and rules all things.



Hosanna is a Hebrew word that is used as a way of praising Jesus. The word recognises that Jesus is our saviour - it literally means "Please save us!"

Do you know the story in the bible when the people shouted "Hosanna" to Jesus?

Here is a picture clue to help you!



When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey the crowds rejoiced and praised him, waving palm branches and shouting 'Hosanna!" We remember this event on Palm Sunday, just before Easter.

Take a moment to be quiet. You may like to close your eyes to help you reflect. Think about what is your favourite way to praise and worship God.

Thank God that we can sing to him and praise him today just like the people in the bible did.
