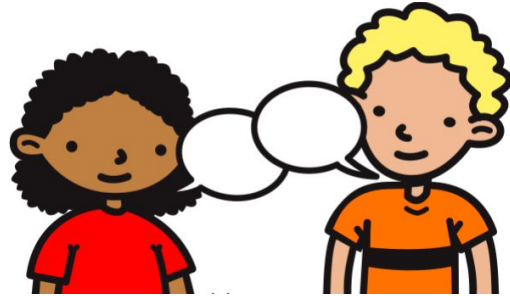


Listen to the hymn together - you can sing along if you would like to!



The chorus of the hymn is:

"Sing Hosanna, Sing Hosanna,
Sing Hosanna to the King of Kings."



Discuss:

- Who is the King of Kings?
- Do you know which language the word Hosanna comes from?
- What does **Hosanna** mean?

The King of Kings is Jesus! The title 'King of Kings' tells us Jesus is powerful and rules all things.

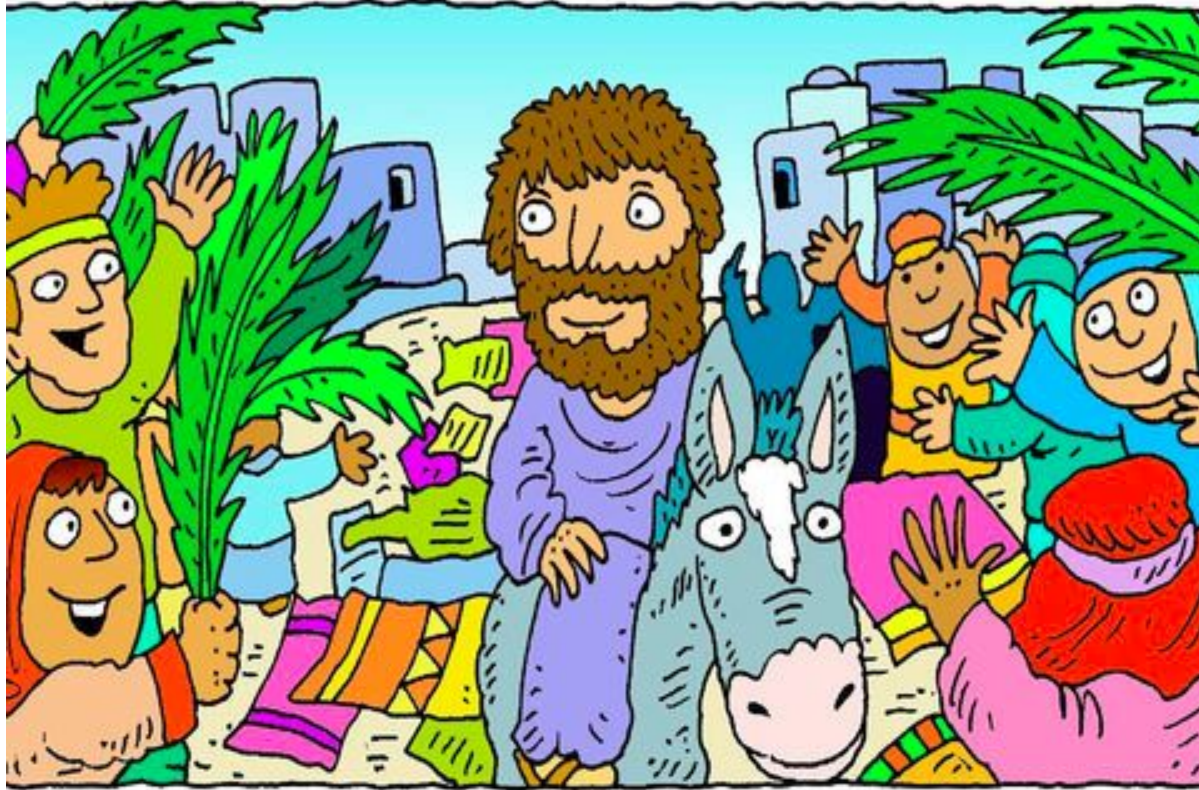


Hosanna is a **Hebrew** word that is used as a way of praising Jesus. The word recognises that Jesus is our **saviour** - it literally means "Please save us!"

Do you know the story in the bible when the people shouted "Hosanna" to Jesus?

Here is a picture clue to help you!





When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey the crowds rejoiced and praised him, waving palm branches and shouting **'Hosanna!'** We remember this event on Palm Sunday, just before Easter.



Reflection:

Take a moment to be quiet. You may like to close your eyes to help you reflect. Think about what is your favourite way to praise and worship God.

Prayer:

Thank God that we can sing to him and praise him today just like the people in the bible did.
