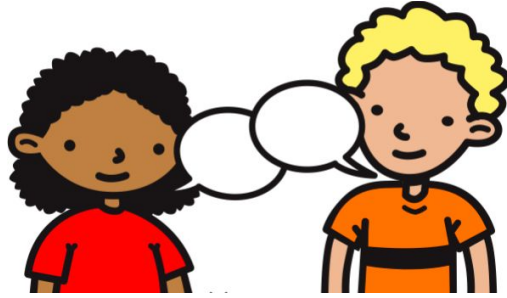

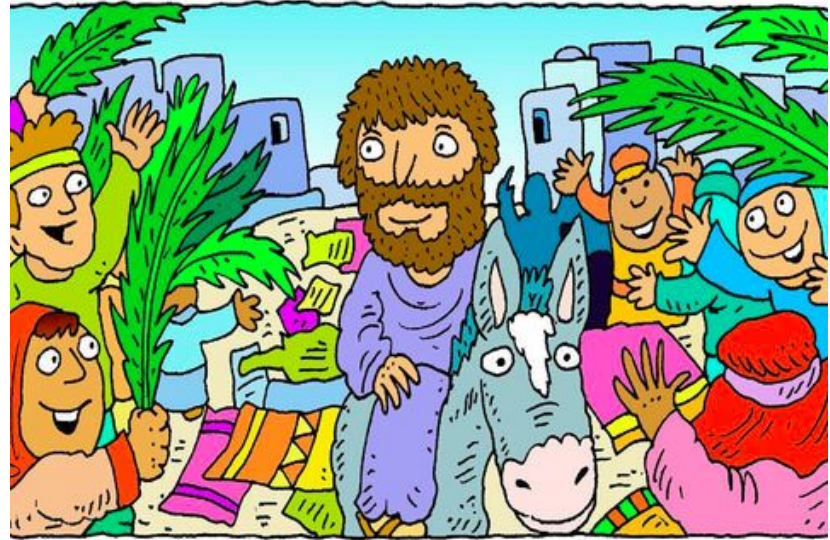
Recap:

- Do you remember what language the word Hosanna is from?
- Do you remember what **Hosanna** means?

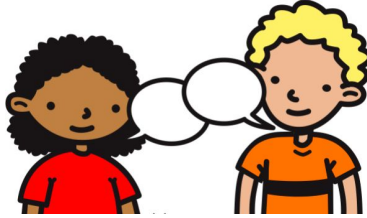


Hosanna is a **Hebrew** word that is used as a way of praising Jesus. The word recognises that Jesus is our **saviour** - it literally means "Please save us!"

When Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey the crowds rejoiced and praised him, waving palm branches and shouting '**Hosanna!**'



Discuss:



- In each of the three verses we ask God to give us something. What are the three things?

Joy, Love and peace

- According to the hymn what will love help us to keep doing?

Love will help us to keep serving - it helps us do things for God and other people



Reflection:

Are there times when you find it difficult to put others first and to help other people? At those times we can ask God to give us **love** in our heart for those around us.

Prayer: Ask God to bless your class with **love** for each other that can show itself in acts of service and kindness.
