Bring your garden to school on Wednesday 27th March



You could use a plastic tray, old shoe box, cardboard box or flower pot to create your Easter Garden.



What has been used to make these gardens? What has been included? Why? Use some soil, small plants, stones, twigs and other natural materials or recycled objects to create a garden with an Easter theme!







- 1. Choose what symbols/objects you will use to represent the Easter story (e.g. the cross, the empty tomb, eggs and spring flowers to represent new life)
- 2. Draw your garden design out on paper
- 3. Make a list of the materials you will need ask an adult for help with this!
- 4. Follow your design and create your Easter Garden
