Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms.

1 Peter 4:10

As we journey through Lent we are focussing on the Christian Value of service through the words of Peter, one of Jesus' disciples, who explains that we should use the gifts God has given us, not for our own benefit, but to serve others. We have been looking at the different ways we can use our gifts to serve others at school, at home and in our communities. Children have noticed the importance of small acts of service such as helping a classmate, tidying up the classroom, making their beds, or organizing games in the playground. We have talked about other acts of service that have been shared by the wider community this week. We were delighted to deliver a very packed car load of donations to Ealing Foodbank as well as pre-loved home items for our PTA Bag2School donations. Some members of our school choir attended Prom Praise at the Royal Albert Hall this week and it was wonderful to experience them sharing their gifts through song and worship.
