





Key Knowledge

Traditional tales are stories that have been told for many years therefore becoming a story many people know. These stories include Goldilocks, Little Red Riding Hood and Rapunzel.

Traditional tales include a beginning which introduces the characters and describes the setting of the story. They usually have a problem and a solution often resulting in a happy ending.

A setting is where the story takes place such as a castle, a woods or a jungle. Many of the characters in these stories include animals, princes and princesses.

There are often lots of different versions of the same story that can have many similarities and differences. The traditional tales we are looking at this half term are based in places all around the world.
