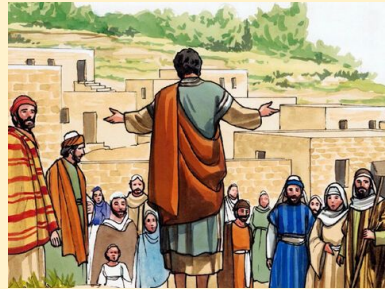
## What does it mean to be a Christian?



### Theology - Believing



At **Pentecost** Peter told the crowds about Jesus. Thousands **repented**, **believed** and were **baptised**. These people were the first Christians.



Jesus taught his followers that the greatest commandment was to **love God** with all your heart and to **love your neighbour** as yourself.



Jesus told the parable of the **Good Samaritan** to teach his followers to **love** their neighbour.



**Saul** hated Christians. But then Jesus appeared to Saul, Saul **repented** and became a Christian. He changed his name to **Paul**.

### Social Science - Living



To become a Christian people **repent** and **believe** that Jesus died and rose again.



Christians pray the **Lord's prayer** that Jesus taught them. "Our Father..."



Christians try and **love** God and love their **neighbour**.

parable	A story told by Jesus about ordinary things that teaches us about God.
persecution	When someone is treated badly because of their beliefs it is persecution.
repent	To repent is to say sorry for your sins.
Samaritan	Someone from Samaria.
