Theology - Believing



At Pentecost Peter told the crowds about Jesus. Thousands repented, believed and were baptised. These people were the first Christians.



Jesus told the parable of the Good Samaritan to teach his followers to love their neighbour.



Jesus taught his followers that the greatest commandment was to love God with all your heart and to love your neighbour as yourself.



Saul hated Christians. But then Jesus appeared to Saul, Saul repented and became a Christian. He changed his name to Paul.

To become a Christian people repent and believe that Jesus died and rose again.

Christians pray the Lord's prayer that Jesus taught them. "Our Father..."

Christians try and love God and love their neighbour.
