The Torah

- One God - **monotheistic**
- Jewish people have a special relationship with God through **covenants**
- Waiting for the Messiah
- Belief in heaven and hell

Theology - Believing

Holy Book

The Qur'an

- One God (Allah) - **monotheistic**
- **Mohammed** (pbuh) is the last prophet sent by God
- Muslim should submit to the will of Allah
- Belief in heaven and hell

Social Science - Living

Place of worship:

Church, chapel, cathedral

Key Festivals:

Christmas, Lent and Easter

Greatest commandment is to **love** the Lord your God with all your heart, soul and mind and to love your neighbour as yourself

Social Science - Living

Place of worship:

Synagogue, led by Rabbi

Key Festivals:

Passover, Yom Kippur, Hanukkah, Sukkot

Follow the Jewish law which includes 631 **commandments**, the most important are the **ten commandments**. Keep the **Sabbath**

Social Science - Living

Place of worship:

Mosque, led by Imam, pilgrimage to **Mecca**

Key Festivals:

Ramadan, Eid al-fitr, Eid al-Adha
