Dear Parents,

Our Summer term has been full of exciting curriculum enrichment opportunities across the school including off site educational visits and local field trips - a huge thank you to the parent volunteers who have supported us with these. Our Nursery pupils have shown wonderful empathy and kindness whilst sharing the Nursery with ducklings this week, Reception pupils enjoyed their first educational visit to Perivale Woods, Year 1 pupils were beautifully behaved on their visit to the farm, Year 2 have enjoyed making playdough as part of their maths learning and enjoyed a very lively PTA disco, Year 3 had a thoroughly enjoyable Ancient Egyptian Day to consolidate their recent learning, Year 4 children have taken part in a dance workshop funded by our PTA and inspired by the Bible Story of the Good Samaritan, Year 5 have enjoyed videoing their ensemble glockenspiel performances inspired by classical music and Year 6 have started rehearsals for their end of year performance of Cats. It has also been wonderful to showcase the wide range of instruments taught in school with performances to parents at our after school concerts this term and children from the Broadway site have participated in numerous local competitions including basketball, athletics and tri-golf.

## **Statutory Assessments**

We were incredibly proud of our Year 6 pupils last week as they completed their SATS with maturity and resilience. Our pupils were well prepared for these assessments, with regular practice throughout the year, mock papers to help students with timing, preparing revision cards to help them with key knowledge and a delicious SATS breakfast to start each day. We were impressed with the support Year 6 gave to their peers throughout the week and we look forward to sharing these results with parents in their end of year reports.

More statutory primary assessments occur during the Summer Term and will be carried out in line with our usual routines for school assessments. Staff in Reception continue to assess the progress of our EYFS pupils towards the Good Level of Development; Year 1 pupils will complete their phonics screening check in the week commencing Monday 10th June; Year 4 pupils will carry out their online Multiplication Times Table Check between Monday 3rd to Friday 14th June. All other year groups will complete non statutory assessments which contribute to their end of year reports which will be shared with parents on Friday, 12th July.

## **Sports' Days Summer Term**

A reminder of the dates for our Sports' Days after half term. Parents are warmly invited to attend. Grove Site Sports' Days take place at the Grove Site and Broadway Sports' Days for Years 3 to 6 take place at Perivale Athletics Track. Children should be dropped at school as usual in their PE kit and parents are welcome to make their way to the track, with the first race timetabled to start at 9.10am. The morning is usually finished by about 12.30pm when children will take the coach back to school for an award ceremony. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate parents at the afternoon awards ceremony.

Broadway pupils will eat a packed lunch at the track. A google form will be sent to each year group in advance for parents to indicate if they require a school made packed lunch. We advise parents to bring their own refreshments as there are limited refreshments at the track.

### EYFS wraparound care
