Bethlehem	Where Mary and Joseph travelled to and where Jesus was born
incarnation	The Christian belief that Jesus is God in human form.
Nazareth	Where Mary and Joseph lived
prophet	Someone who speaks God's words
repent	Turn away from the bad things you have done and shown you are sorry
sins	Behaviour that is wrong and makes God sad and separates us from him, often hurting us and other people
trust	To trust someone means to rely or depend on them
trustworthy	Being able to be trusted with important things such as keep promises, being honest, reliable, and doing what is right

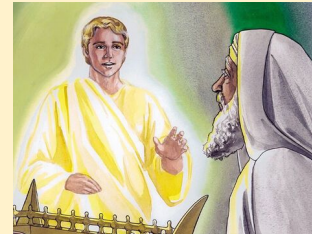
Theology - Believing



Jonah was a **prophet**; he did not trust God at first, but he **learned to trust him** and showed this trust by **obeying** God.



The **angel Gabriel** spoke to Joseph in a dream. Joseph trusted and believed the angel's words about Mary and baby **Jesus**.



Zechariah was a priest. When an angel appeared to him he found it **difficult to trust** God at first but later **obeyed**.



The **Trinity** is the belief that God is **three persons**: the **Father** is the creator, the **son** is the saviour and the **Holy Spirit** is the helper.
