saviour	A person who saves or rescues someone
secular	Not to do with religion or God.
symbolism	Using pictures or colours to express a special meaning.
traditional	Based around a part of culture that is passed from generation to generation.

Christmas is an important religious celebration for Christians because they remember the incarnation, the coming of Jesus into the world. It reminds Christians that

God loved the world. Jesus was the Son of God who came down to earth as a baby. Jesus described himself as the good shepherd and the light of the world.

In paintings, symbolism of objects and colours is used to express religious beliefs.

Christmas is also celebrated by many people who are **not** Christians - many Christmas traditions are not to do with the religious story.


