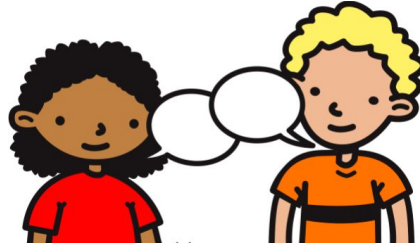

Listen to the hymn and sing along if you would like to.

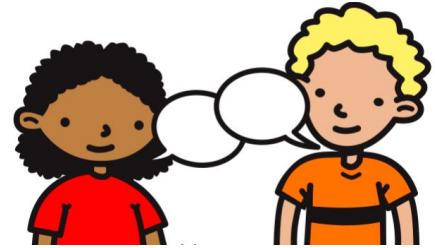


When in a mass service do you think this hymn is usually sung? At the beginning, the middle or the end of the service?

Look at the words of the first verse.
What does the hymn encourage us to do after we
leave mass?

'Go the mass is ended' is a hymn that is sung at the end of a mass or a church service. This type of hymn, the last hymn in a church service, is called a **recessional hymn**.

The hymn reminds us that God wants us to go tell other people about the things we have learned - we are to **tell the world that God is good and kind!**
