Decorating an Easter bonnet is a colourful tradition that goes back to when people would wear new clothes to church on Easter day, including a fancy new hat - or bonnet.

It symbolises new beginnings and reminds Christians of the new life the resurrection of Jesus brings.

How do I make an Easter Bonnet/Hat?



1. Choose what symbols/objects you will use to represent the Easter story (e.g. the cross, eggs, chicks and spring flowers to represent new life)
2. Draw your design
3. Make a list of the materials you will need - ask an adult for help with this!
4. Create your Easter Bonnet - you can either decorate an existing hat or make your own simple hat out of paper or card and then decorate.
5. Wear your Bonnet to school on **Wednesday 2nd April**.
