Listen to the hymn and sing along if you would like to.

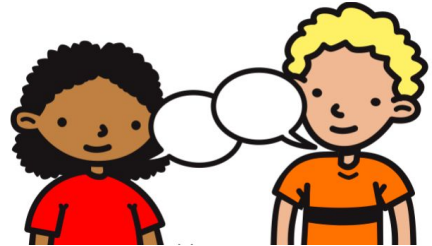
When we sing this hymn we sing more verses.

Jesus died (the sun refused to
shine)
