

# Easter Crown

Follow the instructions below to help assemble your Easter crown.

## Equipment needed:

- crown template
- Easter decorations
- coloured pencils
- glue stick
- scissors
- stapler
- white or coloured card for printing the crown and headband
- optional: other craft materials such as pom-poms or sequins



## How to assemble:

1. Print off the crown and headband template onto white or coloured card.
2. Cut out around the outline of the crown and the crown headband. You may like to ask students to colour in the crown and headband.
3. Glue one end of the headband strip behind the crown. Then, with the remaining piece of headband, wrap it around your child's head to find the correct width. Staple the loose end to the crown.

4. Cut out your preferred Easter decorations using the templates provided or use some of your own craft materials, gluing each onto your crown.
5. Once your students' crowns are ready, you could hold a crown parade or encourage students to wear their crowns while they complete an Easter egg hunt.
