## **Year 6 Leaver Destinations**

We have recently updated our website to show the [leaver destinations](#) of our Year 6 pupils. We send children to over 25 different secondary schools and feedback from our secondary colleagues and from our parents and pupils is that our Year 6 cohorts are always very well prepared for the rigour of the secondary curriculum and confidently take on positions of responsibility and leadership at their new schools. We were pleased to support our Year 6 students in applications to selective schools and gained over 20 offers including full academic bursaries as well as music and art scholarships this year. The

secondary Headteachers commented on our pupils' confidence and ease during the interview process and our staff were able to enhance their references thanks to the wide range of CtS extra curricular activities these children had engaged in.
