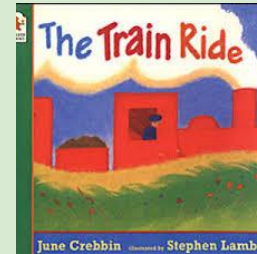
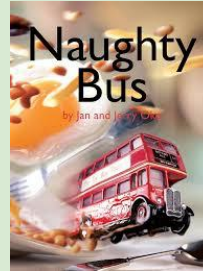
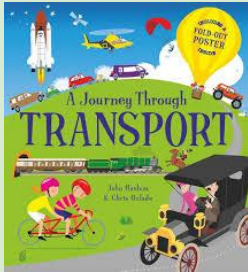

Key Knowledge

A vehicle is a mode of transport to help a person travel from one place to another but can also be used to help people do their jobs. Some modes of transport are healthier for people than others such as bicycles or scooters which some of you may use to travel to school.

There are some vehicles that travel on roads (cars, motorbikes and buses) but there are some can only travel in water (boats and ships) or in the air (aeroplanes and helicopters).

A train is a set of carriages on a railway, a freight train carries good and a passenger train carries people. Some trains go overground and some go underground, we call this the tube.

Buses travel along the roads and alongside cars, in the past were pulled by horses and were wooden open topped vehicles. Buses used to have a driver and a conductor who collected passenger fares.
