Statutory Assessments

We were *incredibly proud* of our Year 6 pupils last week as they completed their SATS with maturity and resilience. Calmly starting each morning with a year group breakfast, it was the first time in over 10 years that every single Year 6 pupil was at school for the four days of these national statutory assessments. This made the administration of the tests more straightforward and ensured that every Year 6 child could enjoy the post - SATs activities this week including a year group trip to the cinema yesterday, an afternoon of games and the commencement of their rehearsals for their end of year performance of “Annie” led by our professional musical director Andrew MacMillan and choreographer Sophie Allistone.

More statutory primary assessments occur during the Summer Term and will be carried out in line with our usual routines for school assessments. Staff in Reception continue to assess the progress of our EYFS pupils towards the Good Level of Development; Year 1 pupils will complete their phonics screening check in the week commencing Monday 9th June; Year 4 pupils will carry out their online Multiplication Times Table Check between Monday 2nd to Friday 13th June. All other year groups will complete non statutory assessments which contribute to their end of year reports which will be shared with parents on Friday, 11th July.

Sports’ Days Summer Term

A reminder of the dates for our Sports’ Days after half term. Parents are warmly invited to attend. Grove Site Sports’ Days take place at the Grove Site and Broadway Sports’ Days for Years 3 to 6 take place at Perivale Athletics Track. Children should be dropped at school as usual in their PE kit and Broadway parents are welcome to make their way to the track, with the first race scheduled to start at 9.10am. The morning is usually finished by about 12.30pm when children will take the coach back to school for an award ceremony. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate parents at the afternoon awards ceremony.

Broadway pupils will eat a packed lunch at the track. A google form will be sent to each year group in advance for parents to indicate if they require a school made packed lunch. We encourage parents to bring their own refreshments to the track and even a picnic blanket if the weather permits to make the morning an enjoyable and community based experience!
