That all may go in.**



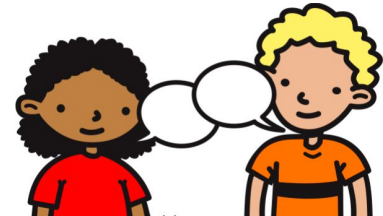
Listen to the hymn and sing along if you would like to.
