Spirited Art Competition

We are really pleased to be taking part in this year's NATRE Art competition (National Association of Teachers of Religious Education.) A recent visit from our Church School Advisor demonstrated how passionately our pupils talk about their faith, worship and wider concepts such as spirituality. In this competition, children are invited to create art about a sacred space that matters to them. A place of worship such as a church, synagogue, chapel or mosque can create wonder and awe, but some people's sacred space might be the beach, mountains or even a busy city. God is found everywhere!

Children may like to base their work on a school trip or a place they treasure personally. They might explore how sacred spaces connect to texts, beliefs or experiences. Entries can be through art, poetry, music or sculpture. Children should bring whatever they have created to school after the Easter holiday.
