Dear Parents,

We have had a really busy half term with some tremendous learning in all year groups. Reception International Day was a real highlight as it demonstrated our wonderfully diverse community with children and staff sharing their heritage and traditions. Our last census showed that Christ the Saviour has families from over 60 different countries speaking 47 different languages and we celebrated this diversity through the children's cultural costumes and traditions on our Reception International Day.

## Menu

We have had a slight delay in printing our new lunch menu. This will be emailed to you next week with a printed copy coming home in book bags in the first week of the Summer term. The guiding principles behind the menu changes were the nutritional content balanced across two weeks, reducing food waste and responding to pupil feedback. We are exceptionally proud of our two kitchens and the pride with which our catering team serve the pupils and make adaptations to the menu for individual needs to encourage all children to "eat the rainbow" on their colourful plates. Meals are cooked from fresh ingredients on both sites with bread baked daily and high quality nutritiously rich salads to accompany every meal. As a result of rising food costs, the school budget now subsidizes the running of the kitchens to ensure our pupils continue to enjoy their lunchtime experience.

## Maintenance Fund

The school remains open for ongoing maintenance over the Easter holiday. Thank you to families who have generously contributed to our Governor Fund which supports the ongoing maintenance of our school buildings. This fund will contribute to the costs of a full boiler replacement at the Broadway Site and re-laying some of our playground surfaces in the Summer so your donations are very much appreciated and needed to keep our school environment at a high standard.
