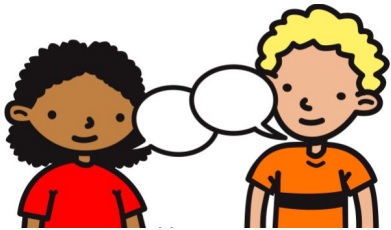


Listen to the hymn and sing along if you would like to.

- What do you think the hymn writer means by 'the dance'?
- What does it mean to 'Dance then, wherever we may be'?

The Lord of the Dance is **Jesus!**

This is not a name used for Jesus in the bible but the hymn writer has used picture language (metaphor) to describe **life as a 'dance'.**

The hymn calls us to **follow Jesus,** wherever we are; he is the Lord of the Dance, he will **lead us.** We are called to follow him in the **'dance' of life.**
