It has been a very busy half term with lots of new learning from Nursery to Year 6. World Environment Day

Anti-Racist Policy

We are pleased to share with you our new Anti-Racist policy which is the result of ongoing work since 2020 including changes to our curriculum, staff engagement in race equality training and a parent, staff and pupil consultative group. The intention of the policy is to support open dialogue and encourage transparency around how the school responds to racist incidents. We will continue to monitor the implementation of the policy throughout the next academic year and welcome feedback from parents.

Pupils in Year 4, 5 and 6 actively engaged in assemblies and workshops this week learning more about racism. It was a pleasure to hear such encouraging comments from the facilitator Joy about our wise and thoughtful pupils, one pupil commented: *It was inspirational and educational because it taught us about racism and what we can do to stop it.*

Cultural Heritage Day on Friday, 3rd July

We look forward to celebrating the diversity of our school community on this day when all children and staff are invited to come to school in their traditional dress or national colours. Each year group will be taking part in a carousel of activities which have been decided by the pupils and staff will be delivering a personal show and tell for pupils!

Uniform

Parents may be aware of the Government requirements for schools to ensure uniforms are affordable. From September 2026 schools must limit **compulsory branded** items to a maximum of 3. Please find below a list of the compulsory branded uniform items which should be purchased from our uniform supplier Juniper.

Grove Site: School book bag with CtS logo | white shirt with tie **or** red gingham shirt | House-colour sweatshirt with 'lozenge logo'

Broadway Site: Black blazer with embroidered CtS badge | white shirt with tie **or** red gingham shirt | House-colour sweatshirt with 'lozenge logo'

Other branded uniform items such as our House- colour t-shirts, school rucksacks, knitted scarf, school baseball cap, winter knitted hat and red cagoule will remain available from Juniper although none of these will be compulsory. When parents chose a non-branded alternative such as a black school bag or house coloured t-shirt these must be plain with **no logos**.

Thankfulness

We are particularly grateful for our fantastic PE team who have not been deterred by the endlessly changing weather and have continued to deliver our excellent sports' days which give pupils the opportunity to demonstrate the skills they have acquired in their PE lessons in the Summer term. These athletic skills of running, jumping and throwing are built on year on year and result in some impressive results as well as building resilience and determination, not to mention fantastic team work and sportsmanship! Preparation for Hot Weather

It is forecast to be very warm next week. We encourage children to keep hydrated and take regular water breaks, please make sure your child has a named water bottle with them in school. We are unable to apply suncream to your child during the school day but if a child needs to reapply suncream they will be supported by an adult to do this independently. Children are welcome to bring sun hats to school. Please do not send in battery operated fans, children may use paper fans if they wish to do so. If during this spell of unusually hot weather your child will be more comfortable coming to school in their PE kit they are welcome to do so.
