Dear Parents,

This week we have focussed on the lines from our school vision “*preparing children to be educated citizens in a global world.*” We have thought about the importance of caring for God’s world and our individual and group responsibilities to look after the world God has created. This learning links to our Active Travel week after half term and our whole school Science Day which you can read about below. We have encouraged children to remain active over half term and reminded them to keep their screen time to a minimum and to continue to eat a healthy, colourful plate.

Anti-Racist Policy and Cultural Heritage Day, Friday, 3rd July

It has been a pleasure to work with some inspiring parents from our school community on the development of our anti-racist policy which we will be launching after half term once this has been approved by our Governing Body. We are really grateful to all the parents who gave their time to engage in this important policy development and professional dialogue with staff and Governors and to offer their thoughts and wisdom. As part of our policy launch next half term we have arranged for workshops to be delivered by staff from the [anti-racist school](#) to Year 4,5 and 6 classes as well as a celebration of our wonderfully diverse community through a Cultural Heritage Day on Friday, 3rd July. Children and staff will be invited to come to school in their traditional dress or national colours.

Whole School Science Day, Friday June 5th

We are marking World Environment Day on Friday June 5th, with a Whole School Science Day when we will be discussing and learning about how we can look after God’s world. Each year group will carry out science experiments to help them learn and understand more about how our world has become polluted and what we can do to help clean it again. As part of the day each class will have a ‘Looking after God’s World Show and Tell.’ Every pupil will have the opportunity to share something they do at home with their families to help look after the environment. Please support your child to think about the everyday actions you do as a family, to reduce, reuse and recycle and what your child could share with their class. Pupils may bring in an object to talk about, or parents may wish to share a photo or a video with their class teacher beforehand which the pupil can then share with the class.

Active Travel Week: Monday June 1st - Friday June 5th

Our CtS Active Travel week takes place after half term. The children had a presentation from our pupil travel ambassadors about travelling to school in active ways:

You can walk, scoot, cycle or even skateboard! If you come by public transport why not get off a stop earlier and walk further from the bus stop? If you have to use the car please remember to ‘Park and Stride’, parking safely away from the school and walking or scooting the last part of the journey.

Statutory Assessments

We were really proud of our Year 6 pupils last week as they completed their SATS with maturity and resilience. Calmly starting each morning with a year group breakfast, our Year 6 cohort approached the tests with confidence knowing they had been very well prepared by their teachers. Our Year 6 pupils have been enjoying some post - SATs activities this week including a trip to the bowling alley, an afternoon of games, the commencement of their rehearsals for their end of year performance and the Year 6 Disco on 11th June.

More statutory primary assessments occur during the Summer Term and will be carried out in line with our usual routines for school assessments. Staff in Reception continue to assess the progress of our EYFS pupils towards the Good Level of Development; Year 1 pupils will complete their phonics screening check in the week commencing Monday 8th June; Year 4 pupils will carry out their online Multiplication Times Table Check between Monday 1st to Friday 12th June. All other year groups will complete non statutory assessments which contribute to their end of year reports which will be shared with parents on Friday, 10th July (Year 5 classes on the residential trip will receive their reports earlier in the week).

Sports' Days Summer Term

A reminder of the dates for our Sports' Days after half term. Parents are warmly invited to attend. Grove Site Sports' Days take place at the Grove Site and Broadway Sports' Days for Years 3 to 6 take place at Perivale Athletics Track. Children should be dropped at school as usual in their PE kit and Broadway parents are welcome to make their way to the track, with the first race scheduled to start at 9.10am. The morning is usually finished by about 12.30pm when children will take the coach back to school for an award ceremony. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate parents at the afternoon awards ceremony.

Broadway pupils will eat a packed lunch at the track. A google form will be sent to each year group in advance for parents to indicate if they require a school made packed lunch. We encourage parents to bring their own refreshments to the track and even a picnic blanket if the weather permits to make the morning an enjoyable and community based experience!

It is a strong tradition at our school - and a significant financial commitment - that our Year 6 cohort finish their primary years with a high quality production accompanied by professional musicians. The Year 6 production of Aladdin will take place in the last week of term (Monday 13th July - Thursday 16th July) at 5.30pm. Each class will do their performance twice, once to the school and once to invited parents. Dates for each individual class performance will be announced by our musical director and choreographer after half term.

It is a tradition to celebrate the achievements of all our pupils during an end of term Mass to which parents are warmly invited. At the Grove Site Reception and Year 1 children will receive their certificates in class later in the day.
