

Dear Parents,

The UK Met Office has announced an Amber Extreme Heat warning for this week. In light of this extreme heat, on Tuesday 23rd, Wednesday 24th and Thursday 25th we are offering parents an opportunity to collect their child early if their child particularly struggles with the heat and a cooler environment can be provided at home in the afternoons. The optional early pick up time will be 1:30pm for the Grove site and 1:40pm for the Broadway site.

Please note we cannot facilitate ad hoc collections throughout the afternoon as this will be disruptive to the continuing lessons. Year 6 children are not permitted to leave school early with a red card.

In addition we have reviewed the timetable of events planned for this week and listed below the changes that have been made to accommodate the extreme heat. All clubs, including Sunset Club, will run as usual and activities will be adjusted.

Monday 22nd June

Tuesday 23rd June
