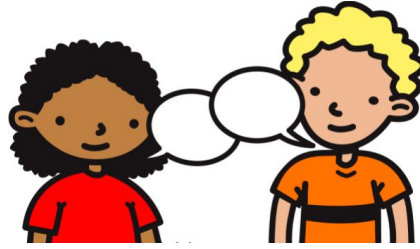

That brightens up the sky.



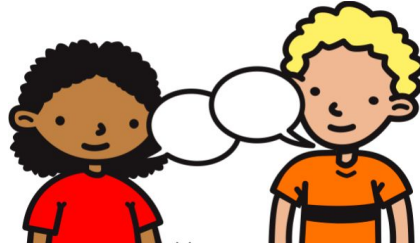
The cold wind in the winter,
