Year 6 SATS results

Unfortunately, there has been a national delay to this year's KS2 test results. We were due to receive the results on 7 July. However, Pearson Education Limited, the provider responsible for administering, marking, and returning Key Stage 2 results to schools has informed the Department for Education of a delay affecting the national system used to make results available to schools. We have been reassured that this delay is not related to the quality of the tests or the accuracy of pupils' results. Test papers have been marked in line with usual processes. Results will now be available on 16 July and we will ensure they are shared with pupils and parents before the end of term.
