

# School maintenance fund



**At CtS, we are fortunate to have excellent teaching facilities, and a safe, nurturing environment. This is thanks to our planned, ongoing programme of building maintenance and development, and generations of parents of CtS pupils whose donations have contributed to the high standard of facilities we enjoy today.**

Voluntary contributions to our Maintenance Fund help us to accommodate increased costs, budgetary pressures and our ambition to offer excellent educational facilities for all our pupils. The Governing Body manages the School Maintenance Fund and most parents make the recommended contribution of £84 per pupil per year. Families fortunate enough to have the means to contribute more do so – and we are grateful for this.



## How the fund is used

A significant proportion of Christ the Saviour's maintenance fund goes towards the insurance, maintenance and refurbishment of school facilities for the benefit of current and future pupils.

In the 2025–26 financial year our maintenance fund has contributed to:

- A new playground surface at the Broadway site (£37,000)
- Fire safety, including servicing of all fire extinguishers
- Full boiler plant replacement and routine servicing at Broadway site (£110,000)
- Tree surveys
- Maintenance audits and associated repairs

## How much to pay

- 12 monthly payments of £7 per month; or
- three termly payments of £28 per term; or
- one-off annual payment of £84

The suggested amount of £84 per pupil per year will appear in ParentPay under the heading "Maintenance Fund".
