Sunrise Breakfast Club

Our breakfast club is open from 7.45–8.30am providing children with a tasty breakfast including a variety of cereals, toast with spreads, fresh fruit and milk.

Each day we offer a range of indoor activities including Lego, board games, drawing, reading, song time and storytelling.

Breakfast club is held in the hall at the Grove Site and there is always one member of the EYFS teaching staff in attendance to support our youngest pupils and to walk them to their classrooms to hand over to the class teacher at the end of the breakfast club session.

A one-off registration fee of £4 must be paid in advance. There is no need to pre-book breakfast club sessions but please ensure your child's breakfast club payments are always in credit. Children will not be permitted to attend breakfast club if debt exceeds £12.

Sunset Nursery and Reception After-School Club

Our popular sunset after-school club for Nursery and Reception pupils is staffed by our own friendly CtS teaching support staff.

The club is based in our Nursery classroom and offers a range of structured learning activities that support our EYFS curriculum. Our vision is to support working parents with some of the activities children usually experience at home such as:

- Cooking skills including chopping and cutting
- Dressing skills including buttons, zips and shoe laces
- Storytime and phonics activities
- Number games

Regular sessions should be pre-booked through the bookings system on ParentPay. Ad hoc sessions must be booked by 2.30pm and are £20 per session.

Late collection charge: £10 for the first 15 mins and £5 for every additional 5 minutes.

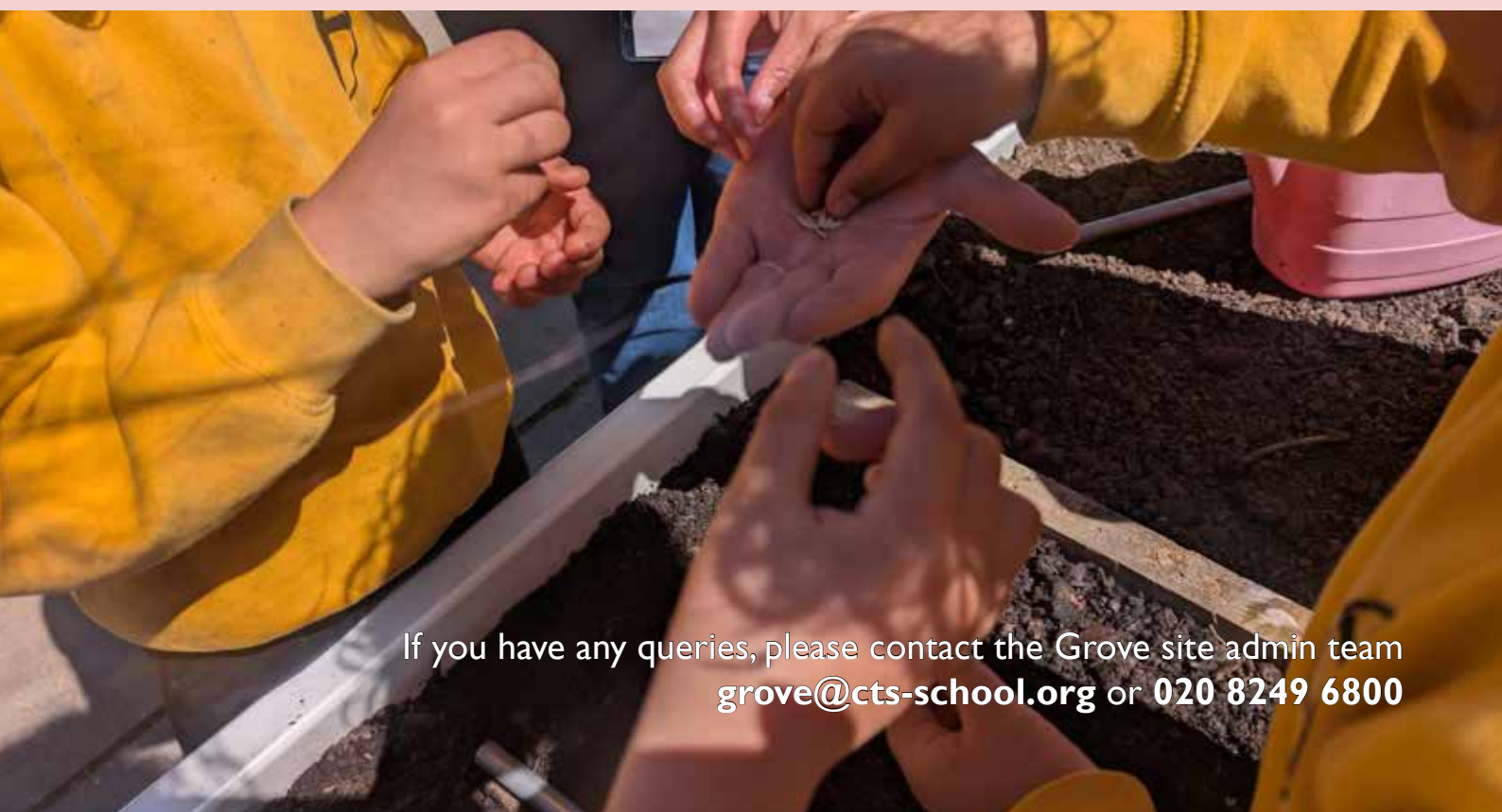
Childcare Grant Payment Service in partnership with Student Finance England
